Inoperable Unlicensed Vehicles

Junk: Garbage, waste refuse, trash, any used motor vehicle upon which no current license plate is displayed, any inoperable motor vehicle, any used tire or used motor vehicle part, any inoperable machinery, and any scrap material, such as metal, paper, rags, cans or bottles. Junk shall not apply to farm machinery owned by the farm operator of an operating farm.

Inoperable Vehicles....

- 🚗 may become a home for rodents, mosquitoes, insects, and other vermin,
- 🚗 may be a fire hazard if they contain flammable substances,
- 🚗 may pose a danger to the public, particularly small children (who are often attracted to junk motor vehicles), due to loose, sharp, or jagged parts, and
- 🚗 contain fluids that, if leaked, may contaminate the environment.

Options Available for Disposal

Sauk County does not allow excessive inoperable or unlicensed vehicles, we request your cooperation in addressing inoperable vehicles. A number of options are available:

- 🚗 The vehicle may be placed in a closed garage.
- 🚗 The vehicle may be made operable and licensed.
- 🚗 Local salvage yards often pay cash for inoperable motor vehicles with a title or junk certificate.
- 🚗 Call the Planning and Zoning Department or the Public Health Department for other options.

Many individuals park inoperable vehicles on their property with the eventual plan to make them road-worthy. Unfortunately, they reduce property values and pose a threat to the public.

Please give serious, and immediate consideration to one of the listed options.
