

LOOKING FOR INFORMATION REGARDING PENDING FORECLOSURE SALES???

It is the responsibility of the Sauk County Sheriff's Department to post and conduct foreclosure sales. Foreclosure sales are advertised in the Baraboo News Republic and are posted at the Law Enforcement Center on Lange Court and inside the west entrance to the Sauk County Courthouse at 510 Broadway.

The pending sales are also posted on the official Sauk County Website:
www.co.sauk.wi.us
under the quick link titled "Foreclosure Listing"

Assessment and tax information for the properties can also be accessed at the County website by going to the link "Property Tax Info. (*Soaring*)"

Once in the Soaring site, place your cursor over the 'Go To' oval and click on 'Property Tax' in the pop up box.

The screen will now say 'Welcome Public User' and from here you can search by parcel number (Muni Parcel), owner name or address.

If searching by name, you must enter just the last name in the search field.

Please note that searching by address may not link you to complete information since vacant land parcels do not have addresses.

When you have found the parcel you wish to research, clicking on the drop box under 'Links' shows the options available.

'Tax Details' will give you the assessed and fair market values and original tax amounts for the year selected. *Note that you should change the year to the previous year for the most current tax, assessment & market value information available.*

To determine if there are outstanding taxes for any years choose the "Delinquent Calculation" box - this is the one screen that shows all years' taxes, interest & penalty if still due.
