RESOLUTION NO. 14/109

DECLARING A PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY DUE TO THE H1N1 FLU OUTBREAK

WHEREAS, a public health emergency, namely the outbreak of the H1N1 virus has struck Sauk County; and

WHEREAS, there are approximately sixty-thousand (60,000) residents in Sauk County requiring vaccination and the Public Health Department has exceeded its resources to provide these services; and

WHEREAS, the State of Wisconsin and the Federal Government have granted funding to the local public health departments to vaccinate or oversee the vaccination of the County residents; and

WHEREAS, Sauk County may not be able to provide the same level of public health duties required by Wis. Stat. ch. 251, Wis. Admin. Code Ch. DHS 140, and Sauk Co. Code ch. 3 during this public health emergency; and

WHEREAS, a declaration of a Public Health Emergency will allow the Public Health Department to allocate their resources more effectively, protect volunteers from liability, clarify the County's priorities and coordinate with other jurisdictions, including for funding opportunities; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Sauk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, that pursuant to Sauk Co. Code § 42.05 (1)(a) and Wis. Stat. § 323.11 a Public Health Emergency is hereby declared in Sauk County. This Declaration shall be effective for sixty (60) days from the date of this resolution.

ORDERING COUNTY CLERK TO ISSUE TAX DEEDS ON UNREDEEMED CERTIFICATES

WHEREAS, your Property and Resource Committee has been informed by Elizabeth Geoghegan, Sauk County Treasurer, that real estate taxes for the year 2005 remain unpaid for certain properties; and

WHEREAS, your Committee is also informed that all of the statutory requirements concerning notification and the publication of notices for said properties with unpaid taxes for the year of 2005 have been completed; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 75.14(1), the County Board, by resolution, may order the County Clerk to execute to the County tax deeds for such properties; and

WHEREAS, such resolution is the next necessary step in the equitable enforcement and collection of real estate taxes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the County Clerk of Sauk County is ordered to execute and issue a tax deed in favor of Sauk County upon all lands for which Sauk County owns and holds tax certificates remaining unredeemed for the year 2005.
