50.01 Definition. The term "*Wisconsin Statutes*" whenever used in this code hereby defined to be the statutes of the State of Wisconsin, unless otherwise indicated.

50.02 Savings Clause. That no inconvenience may arise by reason of the revision and consolidation of the general ordinance of the County of Sauk, it is declared that all vested rights, pending actions and prosecutions, both as to individuals and bodies corporate, shall continue as though no change had taken place.

50.03 Repeal. Repeal of all ordinances of the County which are inconsistent with the provisions of the new code. All general ordinances, conflicting with or inconsistent with the provisions of this Sauk County Code of Ordinances are hereby repealed, but nothing herein contained shall be construed to repeal any special ordinance outside the scope of this code, such as a salary ordinance, ordinances relating to bond issues, etc.

50.04 Severability Clause. The provisions of this Code of Ordinances are declared to be severable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this code shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, clauses and phrases of this code but they shall remain in effect, it being the legislative intent that this code shall stand notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.
