### Friendly Reminders:

- Checks can only be used for locally grown produce. Vendors will tell you what is and is not local.
- Vendors can not give change. For example: If you have \$4.50 worth of produce, grab something else to make it \$5 so you don't lose the \$0.50.
- Please note that cash can be used to supplement the checks if what you are purchasing is over the \$5 and you do not want to use an additional check.
- Checks can be used anywhere in the state of Wisconsin as long as the market or stand has the yellow vendor sign.
- There is an example of this sign in the Wisconsin Farmers' Market Nutrition Program brochure.
- All checks must be used by October 31, 2023. Checks become void after that date.
- Checks must be treated like cash. If they are lost or stolen, they cannot be replaced.
