

WHAT IS TELE-ASSURE?

Tele-Assure provides you with daily telephone contact – a friendly voice to brighten your day and assure your well-being. If telephone contact between the Aging and Disability Resource Center and you isn't able to be made, the emergency contact of your choosing will be contacted to check on you. If the emergency contact isn't able to check on you or we are unable to reach them, the local police department will be contacted to do a "well person check" to ensure that you are safe.

WHO IS THE TELE-ASSURE PROGRAM INTENDED FOR?

This program is intended for any Sauk County resident 60 years of age or older who feels they would benefit from daily telephone or email contact.

WILL I BE CONTACTED EVERY DAY?

The Tele-Assure program operates when the office is open. We are not open on weekends or holidays. We recommend that you set up a weekend/holiday contact person for those days

WHAT IF I AM GONE FOR A FEW DAYS?

If you are planning on being away for a day or more, just notify the ADRC staff before you leave. You may also leave a message on the answering machine any time of the day or night to let us know you are away.

WHEN WILL I BE CONTACTED?

The Aging & Disability Resource Center will call or email you around 10:00 A.M.

HOW DO I SIGN UP FOR THE TELE-ASSURE PROGRAM?

Fill out the attached application and mail it to us. We will contact you to confirm your information and when you would like to begin.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

The safety and well-being of the seniors in Sauk County are our main concern. This program is funded by the Older Americans Act, therefore no fee may be charged. Your donation of any amount toward the cost of the program will be greatly appreciated.
