What is the Volunteer Driver Escort Program?

The Aging & Disability Resource
Center has volunteers available to
provide you with door-thru-door
service. Our drivers will pick you up,
help you to your appointment and
make sure you get back home safe
and sound.

This intercity service is subsidized through the ADRC's **\$85.21 Grant**. The cost to the passengers is \$0.35/mile and will vary per trip. Services are provided as allowed by availability of staff, drivers, and resources.

*Medical rides take priority. Social trips can be accommodated based on driver availability.

Who Is Eligible?

Sauk County residents who are at least 60 years old, and those who are disabled and unable to transport themselves.

What if I need additional assistance?

Each passenger's needs are unique. Wheelchair passengers will be served through our own life-equipped vehicle based on availability. Chairs over 30" cannot be accommodated. Walkers must be collapsible and stored within the vehicle.

If you have special needs, please be prepared to bring a friend or family member who can provide you the assistance you need.
