The reimaged self-guided Shack & Farm tour was designed to provide visitors to the Aldo Leopold Foundation with an engaging, accessible way to learn about the land ethic and Leopold's legacy. Over 400 people explored Aldo Leopold's story and reflected on what a land ethic could look like in their lives through this tour. Early survey results suggest that this new version of the tour is helping visitors better connect to the land community and feel more hopeful about conservation than the previous tour.
