Sauk County Cultural and Historic Resources Designation Questionnaire

Thank you for your inquiry about nominating a property to the Sauk County Cultural / Historic Registry, aka the Landmarks Registry. The Registry is intended to give recognition to properties significant in American and local history, architecture, archeology, engineering, and culture. A property becomes listed in the County Registry after the nomination is approved by the Sauk County Board of Supervisors, on the recommendation of the UW Extension, Arts and Culture Committee (also referred to as the Landmarks Commission). This process is governed under the Sauk County Code of Ordinances, Chapter 38. Section 38.06 of the ordinance contains the review criteria used in evaluating applications.

Applicants will be notified in writing within sixty days of receipt of their application as to the completeness of the application. If more information is needed, a detailed written request for the needed information will be sent by the Landmarks Commission or an appointed designee. If an application is deemed complete, it shall be forwarded for analysis to the Landmarks Commission who will in turn make a recommendation to the Board of Supervisors. Applicants will be notified of the status of their request within ninety days.

Along with the application please include any attachments deemed appropriate; i.e. maps, photographs, sketches, or other descriptive material. Please submit clear, recent photographs that show all sides of the exterior of the structure, views of the interior of the structure, and all associated outbuildings. The photographs will not be returned, but will become a permanent part of our site records. Please include a simple sketch map of the lot on which the property is located, including all structures, adjoining streets, and other major features. Photographs of the buildings should be keyed to this sketch. If the property is rural, please submit a plat map, county map or other detailed map and precisely mark the location.

Written authorization from the property owner(s) of record (page 4 of application) is necessary if different from the applicant. Where such an application is submitted for designation of a historic district, the application must be subscribed by, or on behalf of, a majority of the property owners in the proposed district.
