Tower Lighting RFP Addendum 1

An updated scope of work was posted on the Sauk County website on 1-2-2024

Questions:

- 1. Is this a Davis Bacon or Prevailing Wage Project?
 - a. No, the scope of work does not have a prevailing wage.
- 2. Does the county have pictures of the towers/sites?
 - a. Sauk County has pictures, however they will not be provided as a part of the Addendum.
- 3. The bid mentions a bid and performance/payment bond. This is not going to be an overly costly project. Does the county have a minimum threshold where the bonds are not required?
 - a. A bond is required per the Standard Terms and Conditions.
- 4. Does the kit provide a fastener kit, is weatherproof tape or cable banding to attach the fiber and power wire?
 - a. Steel banding is the preferred method to attach the cabling to tower legs. The use of snap ins on cable guides is also acceptable.
- 5. Can existing conduit be used on a tower?
 - a. Yes, existing conduits can be used if available.
 - b. Weather tight fittings at the various junction boxes need to be used.
- 6. Is an electrical permit required for sites?
 - a. No electrical permit is needed.
- 7. Will the County notify air fields when lights are turned off?
 - a. Contractor is to notify air fields based on work schedule at each tower site.
