

ORDER REGARDING REMOTE HEARINGS DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

On March 22, 2020, the Supreme Court of Wisconsin ordered the suspension of all circuit court in-person proceedings through Thursday, April 30, 2020, with limited exceptions. The Supreme Court also directed each circuit court to utilize available technologies in place of in-person appearances. The Sauk County Circuit Court, Branch 1 – Judge Michael Screnock presiding, will conduct such hearings via telephone and video conferencing hosted by Zoom. Individuals wishing to participate in or observe a court hearing scheduled in Branch 1 are directed to participate using the following options:
