SAUK COUNTY RECYCLING BINS

Assembly Instructions:

- Note the storage arrangement in the trailer for guidance when reloading. Unload all items. WATCH YOUR HEAD!!!!
- Fit the cages around the raised ridge on the pallet frame with the open side of the cage at the corner brace on the frame.
- Screw fasteners into bottom tabs around the frame to hold cage in place. Do not overtighten these screws.
- Use 2 -3 large zip-ties to join the open corner, wrapping them around fence ends and the 'Recycle Here' sign pole to secure.
- Extend the pole to identify bin locations above crowd.
- In windy conditions you may need to brace bins with a fence post or some other means of support. They will blow over.
- Bins are made to be used without plastic liners to reduce waste and costs, but also to make recyclables visible as a guide to use.
- The bins can be emptied into a large recycling dumpster by 2 people lifting the pallet and pouring out the contents.

Storage:

- Remove one screw from each tab and loosen the other.
- Turn tabs off of wires to free up cages.
- Cut zip ties to release pole.
- Collapse cages, folding the small sides toward the same side so they hold each other in place.
- Thread cages onto ropes along side of trailer for support.
- Stack pallets.
- Load poles.
