Admission Requirements by Law

Student must be 18 years of age or at least 21 to drive across state lines and able to communicate in English, both written and orally, able to pass DOT physical and drug test, possess a Wisconsin valid driver license and personal background acceptable to the trucking industry. SCI Commercial Driving School hereby agrees to provide driving instructions to the following student.

SCI Commercial Driving School will provide both Classroom instruction and Behind-The-Wheel instruction at the following hours: DAYS/TIMES. Special occasions may occur where schedules will have made up dates. All information will be communicated based on a change in schedule if necessary.

Program Outline

The driving school will provide E.L.D.T. training required by FMCSA regulations: Theory/Knowledge, B.T.W range/public

Level 1: Entry level driver training, classroom theory, basic information about the trucks, perform safe operations of a commercial vehicle, regulations, paperwork, hours of service, driver and public safety, commercial vehicle inspections and understanding what to look for.

Level 2: Yard movement, pre/post trip inspections truck and trailer, brake check, coupling system, basic vehicle control, straight line backing, offset backing, 90-degree alley dock, controlled turning, proper shifting,

Level 3: Advanced operation training, behind the wheel training, how to maneuver, shifting, range driving, backing, rural, city, urban driving skills. air brakes and lab.

Preparations for CDL testing, vehicle inspection, backing skills, road test

The cost of the course will be individual by level. The fees of the course include vehicle, insurance, materials, and coursework needed to obtain a CDL. Additional fees at the student's expense are DOT physical, learners permit, skills test, road test and driver's license. Cost is to be paid in full prior to start of course, once applicant starts the first day of the course, The school will not refund any tuition if the school is ready, willing and able to fulfill its part of the agreement. Applicant is responsible to fulfill contract terms and conditions.
