They further noted a letter is currently being drafted by the Town's attorney which will formally express opposition.

## <u>Discussion and Possible Resolution Concerning the Notice of Land Acquisition Application by</u> the Ho-Chunk Nation:

Todd Liebman, Corporation Counsel, distributed and discussed a draft resolution entitled, "Expressing Opposition to the Acquisition of Land in Trust by the Federal Government for the Benefit of the Ho-Chunk Nation" (written in response to the acquisition application dated April 20, 2011). The Bureau of Indian Affairs review process was explained and clarification on obtaining a 30 day extension of time to furnish comments was verified. Motion by Bach, seconded by Fordham to approve and forward the draft resolution to the County Board for consideration at the May 17, 2011 meeting and have the Corporation Counsel draft a similar resolution relating to the acquisition application dated April 28, 2011. Motion carried.

Motion by Fordham, seconded by Bach to adjourn. Motion carried and the meeting adjourned at 8:34 A.M. Motion carried.
