Liebman explained minor language changes which were made to the draft of Resolution #52-2011 (Casino Perimeter) approved at the May 10th special meeting and newly written Resolution #53-2011 (Village West Property), created in response to a second acquisition of land in trust request recently received. Discussion followed with a motion by Alexander, seconded by Bach to forward Resolution #52-2011 to the County Board for consideration at the May 17, 2011 meeting. Motion carried. Kathy Schauf, Administrative Coordinator, distributed and explained a resolution amending the CDBG-EAP award which will request reallocation of unused CDBG-EAP disaster rehabilitation monies in the amount of \$11,230.88 for engineering and cost benefit analysis associated with the planning of a drainage district in the Town of Spring Green.
