Departmental Program Summary: The personel of the Coroners Department not only pronounce death when needed, but also issue Cremation Permits, Disinterment and Embalming permits needed in our County. We also assist in the notification of death to families in our County as needed. We work closely with Hospice and Home Health Doctors and nurses to assist in providing help for families of terminal patients in our County. We work with the Sheriff's Department along with all local Law Enforcement Departments in our investigations of death, assisting in the final disposition of bodies.
