Changes / Accomplishments: 2014 was a year or restructure for the health care center with changes in two key department managers, numerous retirements and recruitment of new staff. We also restructured dietary and nursing positions to enhance our services and quality of care. Transition of new leadership in these departments has lead to new efficiencies and changes in programs including revamping of employee orientation, staff development, new staffing program and further expansion of electronic health record capabilities. We will continue to be working on the addition of the home care program to the health care center operations to work on the continuum of services needed for our residents and Sauk County residents.

Statistical Summary: In 2014 we had 109 admissions and 106 discharges mainly from Sauk County with our largest referral base being the Reedsburg Area Medical Group, St. Clare Hospital and Sauk Prairie Hospital.
