Departmental Program Summary: Pronounced death as needed and also issued Cremation, Disinterment and Embalming permits. We were involved in the notification of death to families, both residents and visitors to our County, as needed. We worked closely with the Hospice Program, Home Health Nurses and local Doctors for those whom choose to remain for death at home with privacy and professional medical care. We worked with the Sheriff's Department and all other local Law Enforcement Departments with their investigation of deaths, keeping the chain of evidence intact at all times. Also supported and assisted in the Organ and tissue donation programs, helping many others in our assistance with this program.

In 2016, we had 903 cases that we investigated. That included 481 natural deaths, 53 accidental deaths, 8 suicides, 1 homicide and 360 Cremation Permits. We attended 21 autopsies, did 49 toxicology tests and had 5 unclaimed bodies.
