Departmental Program Summary:

CTH Snow & Ice Control - Maintenance activities to ensure safe winter driving conditions including plowing, sanding, salting and drift control.

CTH Road Construction - County highway rehabilitation and reconstruction projects.

CTH Bridge Construction - County bridge rehabilitation and reconstruction projects.

STH Routine Maintenance - General maintenance of all State highways.

STH Road & Bridge Construction - State highway and bridge rehabilitation and reconstruction projects.

Local Road Maintenance - Local Road maintenance and reconstruction projects as requested by local municipalities.

2016 Goals Review

Changes / Accomplishments: Projects completed in 2016 include the pulverizing and repaving of 8 miles of CTH D and 4 miles of CTH W. Also completed was 12 miles of seal coating on CTH G and 1 mile on CTH GG.


CTH W included culvert replacements between CTH D and CTH DD in preparation for the upcoming road pulverizing and resurfacing in 2017.

Alone with several highway reconstruction projects, the Department also started on the Great State Sauk Trail project with the clearing and removal of trees and brush. This project will continue in 2017.

The Department also added a new 1,000 ton salt storage facility in Hillpoint at the Wards Corners property. A 5,000 ton salt storage facility located at the highway shop in Baraboo will be completed in 2017 which is in conjunction with the Hwy 12 bypass project. Also completed in 2016 was a new equipment storage building at the highway shop in Baraboo.


