- 1) How would you describe the current leadership team at the facility? Has there been any significant turnover recently and/or current unfilled positions? The Director of Building Services (facility maintenance) position is presently open.
- 2) Are there any current collective bargaining agreements with staff? This is not a Union Facility, and therefore no CBA.
- 3) With staffing being an issue industrywide, how are current staffing levels at the Sauk County Health Care Center? We currently have 91 Staff total. 3 RN/LPN Agency staff, 6 CAN Agency Staff. Current openings: 1 Environmental Services, 1 Cook, 1 Tech II, 3 RNs, 7 CAN. Nursing staff if all 4 wings were open (based upon current staffing model) 15 CNAs, 9 RN/LPN. We are averaging 53 clients currently of an 82 bed facility
 - Does the SCHCC utilize agency/contract labor at the facility and if so, do you expect agency/contract labor to continue at the current rate? We are using agency staff (nurses only)
- 4) Can you describe the general census trend at the facility? It is an 82 private room licensed bed facility, and we currently have 1 wing closed. We average 53 on a monthly basis.
- 5) Are all rooms/beds currently operational? If not, are there any recent events or staffing pressures limiting operational capacity? All rooms are operational, and new flooring has been installed in the entire facility. The rooms and facility can be viewed on the virtual tour of the facility.
- 6) How would you describe the competitive position of the SCHCC in relation to the local market? We just finished a County-Wide compensation and classification study, and we are in line with the local market.
 - a. Are there any specialty services that competitors may not offer? We do have space for therapy on site
- 7) Has there been any significant capex/renovation/updates in the past 5 years? All flooring is new in the facility, it is scheduled to have a new HEPA filtration system installed this year. Bids have been accepted, and it is moving forward. This will need to be discussed with the prospective buyer.
 - a. If yes, what work was completed and approximately how much was spent overall? This will be approximately \$1,371,259
- 8) Are there any known significant, immediate capex/maintenance needs that must be addressed in the next 12-24 months? Not known at this time.
- 9) Will the county conduct oral presentations with the prospective brokers? To be determined
- 10) Is there any high-level, relevant information that you believe would be important to our further understanding of the SCHCC and the goals of the county? Part of the sale will be put into a trust to pay off the last 4 years of a bond on the facility. Also see the Resolution that is included with the RFP.
