Sauk County Board of Canvassers opened the ballot bag secured with seal # 0269518; verifying the total number of voters versus total ballots cast on the TSX. It was discovered the last two ballots cast were identical. Adjustments were made to the Inspectors statement and TSX results total tape to indicate this change of (-1 Tom Broughton). The ballot bag was resealed with security seal # 0269596.
