The drug court coordinator/case manager will implement a process of referring potential participants for programming earlier in the legal process in an effort to support the timeline of entry into services. <u>Coordinator/Case Manager:</u> Discussion regarding qualifications to be specified in the RFP. The agreed upon qualifications are as follows: a minimum of a Bachelor's Degree, a WI State Substance Abuse Counselor in Training license (SAC-IT) and two (2) years of experience working within the addiction and/or community corrections field or, any combination of the above and two (2) years working as a case manager/coordinator within a Drug Court Program.

RFP Discussion: The RFP for a case manager/coordinator is discussed and several alterations are made, including: removal of dual credentialed assessor request, change to the number of hours for the second half of year, change to the minimum requirements of the case manager/coordinator and expansion of bullet 1.2.3 to include price options. **Motion by Calkins, second by O'Rourke, to approve the RFP with alterations.**

Discussion on waiting to release the RFP until Human Services applications are reviewed.

Amendment made to original motion to wait to release the RFP based on the results of the Human Services RFP by Judge Evenson. Motion Carried.
