Hoffman updated committee on recruitment updates:

- a. Program Specialist –Jennifer Nelson was introduced and welcomed.
- b. Agriculture Educator Vacant, but working to determine needs of Sauk County.
- c. April Farm Management Friday programs are part of the UW Extension Ag Institute Farm Ready Research meeting series; available to farmers, educators and ag professionals statewide. This is an example of a regional approach program reaching beyond our local area.
- d. Community Development recruitment is complete with Morgan McArthur accepting the full-time position.
- e. 4-H Educator recruitment is complete with Stacy Parsons starting on June 9th.
- f. Certificates of Completion: Hoffman awarded committee members for completing 2 years with Extension (Extension 101) and highlighted what was learned since their time on the Extension Education, Arts & Culture Committee, appreciating all of their time and support of Extension programming.

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<u>Discussion on regional agriculture vision – Heidi Johnson, Ag Institute Director and Matt Hanson, Assistant</u> Dean- Division of Extension

Heidi Johnson, Ag Institute Director and Matt Hanson, Assistant Dean of Extension provided the history on the regional approach Extension is taking with Agriculture. They answered questions on Extension's vision to clarify and help in determining the Ag needs of Sauk County when refilling the Sauk County Ag vacancy. Extension developed a staffing model to allow for specialization in specific areas (ie. Cranberries) with Crop and Dairy Production being a primary need in Wisconsin. Discussions on next steps for committee and how to continue customer service in Sauk County as Ag questions arise.

Agreement for Heidi Johnson to proceed starting the discussions with Juneau and neighboring counties that also have an Ag vacancy (Vernon) to determine possible partnerships.

Educator report on Sauk County programming:

a. Melissa Beernink, FoodWIse Educator:

FoodWIse continues to partner and serve schools and organizations that qualified based on income guidelines. Beernink shared her 2023 partners within Sauk County.
