21.01 Authorization and Purpose. This ordinance is enacted pursuant to § 59.52(24) Stats., in order to provide a means for establishing areas for parking of vehicles on lands owned or leased by the County; for regulating, permitting, prohibiting, restricting or limiting parking of vehicles on such areas or parts of such areas, including, without limitation by reason of enumeration, provisions for parking in such areas or parts thereof for only certain purposes or by only certain personnel; for penalties for violations thereof, and for the enforcement of such ordinances.

21.02 Property and Insurance Committee. This committee of the Sauk County Board of Supervisors, or any successor designated by the Board of Supervisors, is hereby authorized to designate certain areas on County lands for parking on such a limited or restricted basis as it deems conducive to the interests of the County and sound management, in accordance with Section 21.01 of this ordinance. All restricted or limited parking areas shall be clearly posted.

21.03 Penalties for Violating Parking Regulations: (1) Any person violating any parking regulation established pursuant to this ordinance shall be subject to a forfeiture of fifty dollars (\$50.00) for each violation. Each day that a vehicle is parked in violation of regulations established pursuant to this ordinance shall be a separate offense.

(2) Notwithstanding (1), above, the Property and Insurance Committee may direct that any vehicles parked contrary to regulations established pursuant to this ordinance shall be towed away and stored at the owner's expense.

21.04 Enforcement of Ordinance. All officers and employees of Sauk County shall assist

the Property and Insurance Committee in the enforcement of this ordinance, including regulations adopted pursuant thereto. Specifically, the Sheriff of Sauk County and the Sauk County Corporation Counsel shall provide said Committee with any assistance requested by it in the enforcement of this ordinance.

21.05 County Lands Subject to Parking Regulations. Regulations adopted pursuant to this ordinance shall be effective in the following areas:

(1) Outside parking areas at the Sauk County Courthouse.

(2) The parking lot of the Social Services Building.
