

## ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_ - 2012

### AMENDING CHAPTER 28, REGULATION OF TATTOO ARTISTS, TATTOO ESTABLISHMENTS, BODY PIERCERS AND BODY PIERCING ESTABLISHMENTS

**WHEREAS**, the County Board of Supervisors of the County of Sauk does ordain as follows:

**WHEREAS**, Wisconsin Statutes do not require the County to obtain the below information and to do so may be discriminatory and violate HIPAA ; and

**WHEREAS**, it has not been the practice of this Department to obtain such information and our Ordinance needs to be consistent with current practice and the information is not needed to protect the public; and

**WHEREAS**, your Committee has carefully reviewed this matter and does recommend that the attached changes be adopted.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Sauk County Board of Supervisors met in regular session, that the following amendment to Chapter 28 of the Sauk Co. Code of Ordinances, amending § 28.07(5)(a) is hereby amended to reflect the following changes as indicated by strikeout, and all subsequent sections of Sauk Co. Code § 28.07(5) are hereby renumbered, and shall be effective upon passage.

**“28.07 Health and Sanitary Requirements.**

**(5) (a)** ~~The practitioner shall be free of communicable disease that may be transmitted by the practice of tattooing or body piercing. The practitioner shall submit with his/her permit application a certificate from a medical doctor, licensed to practice in the State of Wisconsin, stating that the applicant has within 30 days immediately preceding the date of application been examined and found to be free of any contagious or communicable diseases.”~~
