Food pantries marked with a * in this document are contracted by The Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP). These institutions are equal opportunity providers.

TEFAP Eligibility and Income Guidelines:

Wisconsin households are eligible to receive commodities at participating food pantries if the household meets the Wisconsin Household Income Eligibility Guidelines. TEFAP applicants self-declare income eligibility by determining that their combined household income is equal to or less than the amounts listed in the Wisconsin Household Income Eligibility Guidelines. Proof of income is not required or allowed to enroll in TEFAP.

There are no income eligibility criteria for persons who voluntarily seek meals at soup kitchens or homeless shelters.
