Sexual Health Services for Men & Women

The Family Planning Only Services program for men and women helps you get sexual health check-ups and supplies.

What is covered at a family planning doctor visit?



Men:

- Condoms
- Sexual health check-up
- Tests and treatment for STDs or sexually transmitted infections
- Procedure to prevent future pregnancy: Vasectomy



Women:

- Birth control services and supplies
- Sexual health checkup including PAP test
- Tests and treatments for STDs or sexually transmitted infections
- Surgery to tie tubes (tubal ligation)

All of your information is private, you can have your test results mailed to another address.

Who qualifies?

You can qualify if all are true:

- Any reproductive age (including those under 18)
- Income between \$0 - \$3,284 per month (only count your own income before taxes)
- U.S. citizen, refugee, asylee or legal immigrant age 18 or younger.
If legal immigrant is over age 18, must have lived in U.S. for 5 years or more.
