

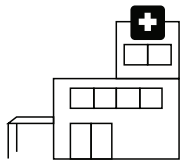
# Undocumented Immigrants



## Health Care Options

**A. Emergency Services** - is a program to help immigrants pay for serious health care emergencies. This program is for children 0-18 years old, adults 65 or older, adults with disabilities, and adults caring for children.

To get your medical bill paid for by Emergency Services, you must have **ALL** of these:



- A medical emergency
- Immigrant Status is one of these:
  - Undocumented
  - Legally present and can't get BadgerCare Plus
- Household salary or income before taxes **at or less than** the number on the chart:



Find your household size and read across to see who will qualify:

⚠ Adults with disabilities or over 65 qualify with different income amounts

**Example:** You and your 7 year-old child get into an accident. You go to the Emergency Room



**Household size:** 4  
**Family:** 2 adults, and 2 kids  
**Income:** \$2,500 a month  
**Child qualifies but you don't**


### To apply:

1. **Call 1-800-362-3002.** Ask for the phone number and address of the agency in your area where you can apply for Medicaid.

2. Apply with the agency in person or by phone.

⚠ Emergency Services pays for care **after** you get a bill.



Always call 9-1-1 or go to the Emergency Room in an emergency.

You **do not need** a social security number (SSN) to apply.

Your information will **not be shared** with INS (Immigration services) or ICE (Immigration and Customs Enforcement).

📞 If you don't qualify for Emergency Services, **call the hospital or clinic.**

Ask about options to lower the bill.

Still not sure what you qualify for?

**Call 2-1-1** for local help  
Ask for an enrollment assister



## B. Go to a free clinic or community health center

To find a clinic near you, **call 2-1-1**. Free clinics help people for free. Community Health Centers have financial help to lower the bill.

## C. Prenatal Services for Pregnant Women

Pays for baby's birth and your health care while you are pregnant.

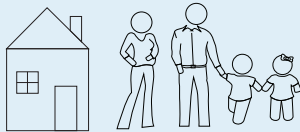


To qualify you must have **ALL** of the following:

- You are pregnant
- Household salary or income before taxes **at or less than** the number in the chart

Household Size - count each unborn baby as 1 child				
2	3	4	5	6
\$4,442/mo	\$5,600/mo	\$6,757/mo	\$7,915/mo	\$9,073/mo
\$53,304/yr	\$67,200/yr	\$781,084/yr	\$94,980/yr	\$108,876/yr

### Example:



Household size: 5  
Family: 2 adults, 2 kids and 1 baby on the way.

Income: \$7,693 or less a month

**Mom qualifies**

### To apply:



I need to apply for Prenatal Services.

**1. Call 1-800-362-3002.** Ask for the phone number and address of the agency in your area where you can apply for medicaid.

**2. Apply with the agency in person or by phone.**

### If you already had the baby and don't have insurance

Emergency Services can pay for the cost of the baby's birth.



**Mom can get 60 more days of health coverage** from Emergency Services after the baby is born.

**Call 1-800-362-3002** and ask how to get your bill covered by Emergency Services.

**⚠ Documented immigrants can also get health care.**
