



With only 1 dentist for every 1,500 Sauk County residents, finding a dental home AND making appointments can be a challenge. Here are a few tips for success we've found work for Sauk County families:



Call in the Morning Need to be seen sooner? Cancelations occur. Call every morning to see if an opening is available. Call if You Can't Make It Some dental providers have a strict no show policy. If you know you can't make your appointment, call right away so your dentist can fill your spot with someone waiting.
