BadgerCare+ Family Planning Only Services (FPOS)

Services: Routine reproductive check-ups, testing and treatment for STIs (sexually transmitted infections), pregnancy testing and counseling, contraception

Eligibility: US citizens living in Wisconsin who meet income requirements

Application: Apply for the program at www.access.wi.gov, or visit Sauk County Health Department Mondays-Fridays 8:00 AM – 12:00 PM for assistance

Eligibility: Anyone regardless of insurance status and income; sliding scale fees
