Health and Dental

IMMUNIZATIONS

are free for adults who have no health insurance, have health insurance with deductibles or copays for immunizations, or are Alaska Native or American Indian. Children 18 years and younger who qualify for BadgerCare, have no health insurance, or are Alaska Native or American Indian are also eligible.

COMMUNITY CARE VOUCHERS

are available for urgent health, dental, or vision care for those with no health or dental insurance.

TESTING IS AVAILABLE

for pregnancy, lead poisoning, and tuberculosis (TB).

SEAL-A-SMILE PROGRAM

provides dental sealants, fluoride varnish, screenings, and dental education to children in area schools.

THE WISCONSIN WELL WOMAN PROGRAM

provides preventive health screening services to women with little or no health insurance coverage.

SAUK COUNTY CREDIBLEMIND

provides mental health support through videos, podcasts, apps, books, and online tools. For more information, visit saukcounty.crediblemind.com



For Parents and Families

WOMEN, INFANTS, & CHILDREN (WIC)

gives healthy foods, nutrition tips, and breastfeeding support to those eligible, including pregnant and postpartum people, infants, and children under the age of 5.

NURSE FAMILY PARTNERSHIP (NFP)

pairs eligible parents with a personal nurse early in pregnancy and continuing after the baby is born. Call or text Michelle at 608-963-6115 with any questions.

PRENATAL CARE COORDINATION (PNCC)

connects pregnant people with their own personal nurse. It is a Wisconsin Medicaid and BadgerCare Plus benefit that helps pregnant people get the support and services they need during and right after pregnancy.

MATERNAL CHILD HEALTH SERVICES

consists of Public Health Nurse outreach for postpartum people and children that need to be connected to resources in our community.

HEALTH & SAFETY CHECKS

Our environmental health team inspects and licenses restaurants and other retail food outlets, lodging, campgrounds, recreational camps, schools, tattoo shops, public wells, and swimming pools.

RADON TEST KITS

We can answer your questions regarding radon and radon testing. You can purchase a radon kit from us for only **\$10.00**. Please note that we take cash or check only.

WELL WATER TEST KITS

Free well water testing kits are available for those with a financial or other burden. The well must routinely serve a pregnant person, a child under the age of 12, or a person with a weakened immune system. Please call 608-355-3290 for more information.
