

WHAT IS TUBERCULOSIS?



LATENT TB

- Inactive TB bacteria in the body, but may become active if untreated.
- There are no symptoms, the person feels well.
- NOT contagious to other animals or people.

TREATMENT

- BOTH latent and active TB require treatment.
- The Public Health Nurse will coordinate treatment if a worker is found positive for TB.
- Effective and essential for reducing the spread to other people and cattle.

ACTIVE TB

- Active TB bacteria in the body.
- Coughing, fever, night sweats, weight loss are possible symptoms
- Contagious, may spread through the air
