Personnel Information

To all our staff who are currently punching the timeclocks: thank you very much for your patience and for taking the time to punch both clocks. We know it is inconvenient for you but it helps us very much in testing the new Timekeeper system and how it will interface with our current Munis payroll system. Please continue to punch on both clocks until further notice. As we get closer to implementing the new system, we will let you know when we will go to punching just the black time clock. Again, thank you for your cooperation, it is much appreciated.

If any employees still have the <u>Benefits Design</u> forms out, please return them to the Personnel Office by Monday, November 19, 2007. If you choose to keep your elections the same, please sign the form and return it. If you decline participation in the program, please sign the very bottom of the form and return it. We need to forward the forms to the <u>Benefits Design</u> office in order to keep your choices of plans current. Please stop in the Personnel Office if you have any questions on these forms.

Attention all staff, especially CNA's: if you leave work early due to overstaffing or other reason, please complete a Time Off Request Form to notify the Personnel staff on how you would like to be paid, using benefit time such as holiday or vacation time. Your choice of benefit time to supplement cannot be conveyed on an absence slip. You, the employee, need to give us your written permission via the Time Off Request Form on how you choose to be paid. Your supplement slips need to turned in to the Personnel Office by 10:00 am on the Monday after payday. If you have questions about this process, please stop in the Personnel Office or call Amy or Mary at your convenience.

Reminder: All staff must wear their name tags at all times while on duty. If you do not have a name tag with you at work, you need to come to Personnel and ask for a replacement tag. The cost is \$1.00/name tag. Also, if you lose your time card, please stop in the Personnel Department for a replacement card, it is very important for us to have accurate time records for each employee. All employees are encouraged to keep their timecards in the badge racks near the time clocks so that there is less chance of forgetting them at home or losing them. If you are concerned about someone taking your badge or moving it, rest assured that this rarely ever happens. The badge rack works as an ideal place to store your card and lessens the likelihood that you will not have your card when you need it.

WINTER WEATHER IS COMING: We are entering the season where snow, ice, etc. are part of our weather. Please remember to check the parking diagrams on the bulletin boards for instructions on where to park during the winter months. Please do not park in the gravel walk ways so that they can be kept clear and used to walk to and from the building. These walkways have additional coarse material on them to give additional traction to help prevent falls. Try to be aware of the changing conditions of the pavement in the parking lots on bad weather days. Check for ice or other slippery spots and go slow to prevent falls. If you do fall in the parking lot, please report your injury to your supervisor and Personnel immediately.

As we come upon the holiday season we are reminded of what we should be thankful for. I, for one, am thankful for the opportunity to be the Administrator of this fine facility. It is truly a privilege to work with so many professional and caring staff people on a regular basis.
