For the new building, if anyone is having trouble with their keys or new ID badge, please see Mary in Personnel so we can get it taken care of.

Also, at our beautiful new building, we still have **two time clocks** where we can badge. One is located next to the employee break room and the other is located next to the front doors. Please feel free to utilize either of these clocks for your convenience when badging. The one by the front door is especially helpful for clocking out in time to prevent incurring unauthorized OT.

Time Off Request Forms are available in the employee break room in the clear shelf near the sink. You can complete them and turn them in to the Personnel Department. You may slide them under the door if the Personnel doors are not open. The process for Personnel staff date stamping the slips and forwarding them on to your supervisor remains the same.

In-House Posting Applications are also available in the employee break room and the postings for any open in-house positions will be located on a soon-to-be mounted bulletin board near the employee break room.
