Personnel Matters

Our NaCo (Nationwide Retirement Solutions) Representative will be here on Tuesday, June 15, 2010 in the employee break room 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm. The representative comes approximately every 3 months. This is a good chance to learn more about this program.

All requests for FMLA need to be directed to our contracted company, FMLA Source. You can stop in the Personnel Office for more information on how to contact them. Additionally, if you have an absence that is related to your approved or pending FMLA, you are required to notify FMLA Source. All employees absent 3 or more days for the same health condition are required to contact FMLA Source to obtain FMLA information. You can contact them by phone or email.
