Personnel Matters

All employees please read carefully: Within a few months, your only resources for keeping track of your available benefit time will be on the bottom of your checks and direct deposit slips and the Munis Self Service website. The balances listed there are current as of the end of the last payroll. Please use these figures to see how much benefit time you still have available, but make sure you deduct any other approved time off to get an accurate balance. On **Munis Self Service**, you can also check your accrual balances, paycheck information, past payroll information and much more. If you need information on how to access this web site, please stop in Personnel for a hand out with this information.

<u>Keeping up on Kronos</u>. Kronos is our in-house timekeeping system. The time clocks you punch on are Kronos clocks. If you haven't already started, please start checking your punches at least every 2 or 3 days or even daily. This will help to ensure that you are punching correctly and make sure you have all of your punches, in and out for lunch and the beginning and end of your shift. If your punches are not accurate - then your payroll may not be accurate - YIKES!!, We all want to be paid accurately - so if you skip a punch - your record will be incorrect. Checking your punches at the clock is a simple step, the buttons are on the front of the clock to review your punches for the previous 72 hours. If you have any questions on this, please call Mary in Personnel at x-7538. Your accuracy on your punches is greatly appreciated.
