

**Restorative/Maintenance tip of the Month:** Self feeding and intake are very important to health and well being. Helpful tips to ensure the best eating experience are: posture should be upright with feet supported, minimize distractions so focus can be on meal, meal should be within arms length, utensils should be handled with ease by person and food should be easy for person to chew, swallow and manipulate. If there are complications, try to readjust, reposition and consult with team for alternatives to try and be sure to document. If simple adjustments cannot be made, seek a therapy screen for possible evaluation and treatment.
