## Restorative / Maintenance tip of the month:

Ambulation Devices: Walkers: when a person is standing erect with hands on grip, the walker should be at height of where hip and leg bend (greater trochanter) and elbows with slight bend. PT is to determine this upon admission or if there are changes. 4 Wheel Walker: be sure brakes work well. Standard Walker: be sure rubber tips and tennis balls are in good condition, and that the frame is stable and level. Cane should be at height person can stand with shoulders level, walking with slight elbow bend when moving cane. Be sure tip of cane is in good shape and that resident uses it on their strong side, moving cane first, then weaker side, followed by strong side. Therapy again will determine this and educate.
