A highlight of 2016 will be Operation Persian Gulf Welcome Home and the Dedication of the Persian Gulf Tribute – July 19-25, 2016.

Operation Persian Gulf Welcome Home is a week-long event honoring all those that served in the Persian Gulf region, including Desert Shield, Desert Storm, Iraq & Afghanistan. To create an important event of this magnitude and length requires a great deal of dedication and support. Costs are kept as low as possible, but there are still significant expenses that cannot be avoided ranging from nationwide publicity to spread the word to all Persian Gulf veterans; booking of the Wall of Remembrance; providing food for the "army" of volunteers; providing valuable PTSD support and books free of charge to veterans and numerous other items. This event will provide a vital service to veterans and families that are now experiencing great difficulty with many issues after the veteran's return to civilian life. 

# Overview as of 3/7/16 Operation Persian Gulf Welcome Home –( July 18 - escort) July 19 – 25, 2016

There is a very important, exciting event happening in July, 2016 for military personnel that served in the Persian Gulf region (Desert Shield, Desert Storm, Iraq and Afghanistan) and all those that support these veterans. During July 19 – 25, 2016 The Highground Veterans Memorial Park (W70321 Ridge Rd, Neillsville WI 54456) will host "Operation Persian Gulf Welcome Home". This 7-day event will honor these veterans, those who lost their lives in the Persian Gulf region and the families of those who served. This is an event for <u>all</u> Persian Gulf veterans across the country, not only Wisconsin. It will be a week of Military Reunions, Healing, Recognition and Remembrance. Below are some of the items that are scheduled and help that is needed. Updates will be posted on The Highground's website, Facebook and in upcoming newsletters as other scheduled events get confirmed.

### Monday, July 18 - Escort of The Wall of Remembrance to The Highground

The "Wall of Remembrance", a nationwide traveling memorial wall honoring all who have lost their lives and all who served in the Global War on Terror (Desert Shield, Desert Storm, OIF, OEF, OND) and all citizens and emergency personnel who lost their lives during the terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001 will be on display at The Highground for the entire week.

The escort will start in Madison at the Harley Davidson of Madison, 6200 Millpond Rd, Madison WI 53718. Registration from 7:30AM – 9:00AM. The escort will depart from the Harley Davidson of Madison location at 9:00AM.

(A limited number of rooms have been reserved at the Magnuson Grand Hotel (3510 Millpond Rd, Madison WI 53718) near the Harley Davidson of Madison for the night of July 17<sup>th</sup>.)

The escort route will be approximately 245 miles long, with breaks and a lunch stop at the Willis Chapel American Legion Post #306 in Green Lake, WI. The escort will travel through the Tomah VA and make stops at the Mauston Harley-Davidson and the Black River Falls Harley-Davidson (Al Muth). The escort is timed to enter The Highground around 6:30PM

### Saturday, July 23 – PERSIAN GULF TRIBUTE DEDICATION DAY

Wisconsin's tribute to those who served in the Persian Gulf, "The Bootprint" will be formally dedicated on Saturday, July 23<sup>rd</sup>. "The Bootprint" is a permanent, major tribute at The Highground honoring all who served in the Persian Gulf region (Saudi Arabia, Iraq, Afghanistan) from Desert Shield to present day. It is a

large outdoor tribute which, like all Highground veterans tributes, is available for veterans and families to visit 24/7 at The Highground. Features of this tribute include concrete Jersey and Texas Barriers, which along with Honor Stones, form a symbolic shape of a military bootprint in the sand. The Persian Gulf Tribute is located on the Eastern slope of The Highground's plaza, making it visible from the plaza but at the same time offering quiet and solitude for those who enter the tribute for reflection and remembrance.
