 - a. Two previous studies were completed

 - b. Sauk County would want to review the existing studies and review operations with the selected candidate to select final size.
- 2. Is there a project budget developed?
 - a. No
- 3. <u>Is there a type of building desired (Pre-engineered, conventional steel, precast)?</u>
 - a. No
- 4. In addition to Fleet Repair space is there a need for Office/Administrative space?
 - a. Yes we will need fleet repair, fleet storage, administrative office space, cold storage, salt storage, brine making facility.
- 5. <u>Are other stand-alone buildings needed for storage or salt included in project scope?</u>
 - a. Yes, salt storage, cold storage, brine production
- 6. Is there a desired time line for completion of design and construction?
 - a. Sauk County's Capital Improvement Plan Currently has Construction in 2023. Using cost estimates from the studies attached in question 1
