County G Roadway Reconstruction project to be discussed at September 20th Public Involvement Meeting located at the Town of Spring Green Town Hall

The planned roadway reconstruction project (located in Sections 1-3, T8N, R3E, Sections 26, 27, 34, and 35, T9N, R3E, Town of Spring Green, and Sections 14, 15, 22, and 23, T9N, R3E, Town of Bear Creek, Sauk County) will be discussed at the public involvement meeting on Wednesday, September 20, 2023, the Sauk County Highway Department announced today.

The meeting will be held from 5:00 PM to 7:00 PM at the Spring Green Town Hall, located at E4411 Kennedy Rd., Spring Green, WI 53588.

The Sauk County Highway Department is proposing to reconstruct the existing pavement structure along with spot roadway realignment at substandard horizontal curves. The vertical profile of the road will be modified to better facilitate drainage while also improving the line of sight and safety along this section of CTH G. Intersection sight distance will be evaluated at the intersections. Culvert pipes/drainage structures will be replaced, and drainage/ditching will be improved throughout the project limits. CTH G will be closed to through traffic during construction operations. Sauk County is currently seeking grant funding for the reconstruction of the CTH G project. The success of the grant applications will determine the year of construction.

The September 20th meeting will begin with a short presentation at 5:00 PM followed by an open house format with a variety of exhibits and maps available for review. Representatives from Jewell Associates Engineers, Inc. will be on hand to answer questions throughout the meeting. Attendees will have the option of making written or verbal comments during the gathering.
