Motion carried unanimously.

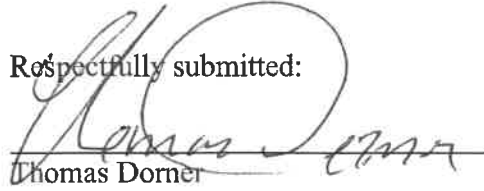
