PROGRAM SERVICES

The Community Support Program delivers a variety of services through a team approach; this team includes a Psychiatrist, Psychiatric Nurses, Licensed Social Workers, Psychotherapists, and Community Rehabilitation Specialists. The Community Support Program team is committed to providing services in the least restrictive environment possible to empower consumers to live safely and productively in their communities and increase independence. *Community Support Program's services include:*

- Psychiatric Evaluation & Assessment
- Medication Management
- Individual Case Management
- Psychosocial Rehabilitation
- Supportive Psychotherapy
- Community Resource Discovery
- Goal Setting & Coaching

There is no cost to participate in the Community Support Program, however, some services are reimbursed through Medicaid or other insurance companies. Consumers may be responsible for the cost of their medication.

CONSUMER-LED SUPPORT

Each consumer in the Community Support Program has a designated Case Manager who oversees their care. Case Managers collaborate directly with consumers to develop a recovery plan, coordinate services, and continually evaluate and adapt services to meet the consumer's needs and ensure safety and stability within their community.

The Community Support Program has various opportunities available to consumers to engage in social, recreational, and program-related activities. The Community Support Program offers regular Drop-In sessions within the community, group outings meant to encourage positive social recreation, and group therapy sessions that increase peer support amongst consumers.



PROGRAM ADMISSION

Admission to the Community Support Program is determined by criteria defined in DHS 63 of the Wisconsin State Statutes. Consumers must be diagnosed with a chronic mental illness and be at risk of severe dysfunction or institutionalization in order to qualify for Community Support Program services.

To find the most appropriate and helpful services through the Sauk County Human Services Department, individuals are encouraged to call (608) 355-4200 to speak directly with an access worker. Those who request services are screened and assessed before being referred to the appropriate program.
