March 2023 collected \$952,000 down from March of 2022. Fully staffed again.

9. Departmental Update and Approve Expenses – Court Commissioner.  
On track on the budget. The pro se family clinic was opened last Tuesday.

Motion by Schell, seconded by Scanlon to approve payment of the Court Commissioner expenses in the amount of \$1,137.25. Bills discussed. Motion carried.

Court appointed and interpreter are down in 2023. Tax intercept and debt collection is down a little in 2023.

Requesting to carry forward \$305,350 of the \$340,194. Motion by Scanlon, seconded by Carver.


