AHC company that provides medical for the jail wants to increase contract for 2024 due to having trouble getting nurses. Either can get out of contract on a 30 day notice. Going to start process to get bids.

Motion by Scanlon, seconded by Clemens to approve payment of the Sheriff's expenses in the amounts of \$177.50, \$256,016.00, \$22,532.69 and \$1,358.08 for December 2023 and \$82,007.06 and \$169.50 for January 2024. Bills discussed. Motion carried.
