Learn all about stockpiling forage to extend your grazing season.

Stop out to see and learn about all that Connor Laukant has going on his farm.

With multiple herds grazing across three farms consisting of 90 red angus pairs, 161 custom grazing animals, two herds of red angus heifers, and a herd of about 20 bulls available for rent there will be much to discuss and learn about at this pasture walk.

Learn about how Connor is working to manage weeds in pastures through different management practices, stockpiling forage to increase the total number of grazing days and decrease the costs of winter feeding, and creating mobile shade structures to help improve grazing on hot summer days.
