- A) I hereby certify that all information, attached construction or abandonment plan are true and correct. I understand that no construction, including but not limited to the pouring of a foundation or basement or the construction or alteration of any other structure may occur before the issuance of all necessary permits and that if building does occur before that time, I am subject to penalty fees in addition to my land use and/or sanitary fee, citations to be paid to Sauk County Clerk of Courts, and/or removal of the non permitted structure(s).
- B) New Construction: I have obtained the services of qualified nutrient management planner per Wis. Admin. Code to prepare a Nutrient Management Plan to fulfill the requirement of the Sauk County Agricultural Performance Standards and Manure Management Ordinance. The Nutrient Management Plan will meet the Natural Resource Conservation Service Technical Standard 590. The plan shall be submitted to the Sauk County Land Resources and Environment Department no later than June 1st of the year following installation of a manure storage facility. The Nutrient Management Plan will be updated annually for the life of the manure storage. Any updated plans will be provided to the Sauk County Land Resources and Environment Department upon request. The recommendations of the Nutrient Management Plan will be followed as closely as possible.
- C) I will allow representatives from the Sauk County Land Resources & Environment Department to access my property to inspect the project's construction, operation and/or maintenance.
- D) The permit card must be posted on-site <u>prior</u> to starting any construction. If proper posting is not done, the property owner maybe found in violation and subject to citations.
- E) The issuance of a land use permit shall not be deemed or construed to be a permit for, or an approval of, any violation of any of the regulations of the Sauk County Code of Ordinances.
- F) Pursuant to §59.691(3) Stats, the applicant must sign below to acknowledge the receipt of the following: You are responsible for complying with State and federal laws concerning construction near or on wetlands, lakes and streams. Wetlands that are not associated with open water can be difficult to identify. Failure to comply may result in removal or modification of construction that violates the law or other penalties or costs.
