Tax parcel identification number 040-0092-00000, and currently owned by Nature Valley Properties LLC. W. Christensen presented the staff report, background, and history. W. Christensen stated that the Town of Westfield Town Board recommended approval of the Planned Rural Development lot and placement of a preservation area easement on January 8, 2024. The LRE Staff also recommends approval. Motion by McAuliffe / Eberl to approve PRD 01-2024 for Levi Troyer to create a 5-acre development lot and the placement of a preservation area easement on the remaining 30 acres as presented based on the findings of fact and conclusion of law, subject to the staff analysis, and subject to conditions as noted in the staff report.
