- I. A. Petition 27-2022. A petition to consider a conditional use permit pursuant to s. 7.027(2)(g) for an agriculture related business. Said conditional use is located in the Town of Reedsburg, Sauk County.

Lands affected by the proposed rezone and conditional use are located in part of the NW ¼, SW ¼, Section 30, T12N, R4E, Town of Reedsburg, and as further described in Petition 27-2022. Tax parcel identification number 030-0996-10000.
