Animal Shelter took in 32 dogs and adopted/reclaimed 30 dogs. They also took in 127 cats and adopted out/transferred out 33 in the month of October. The Animal Shelter also took in 1 ferret, 1 rabbit, 1 pigeon, 1 hamster, and 4 rats. They adopted/reclaimed 1 ferret and 1 hamster. The Animal Shelter dealt with a total of 8 bite cases 3 cats and 5 dogs.. They responded to 36 calls and impounded 8 dogs and 26 cats and 1 ferret.
